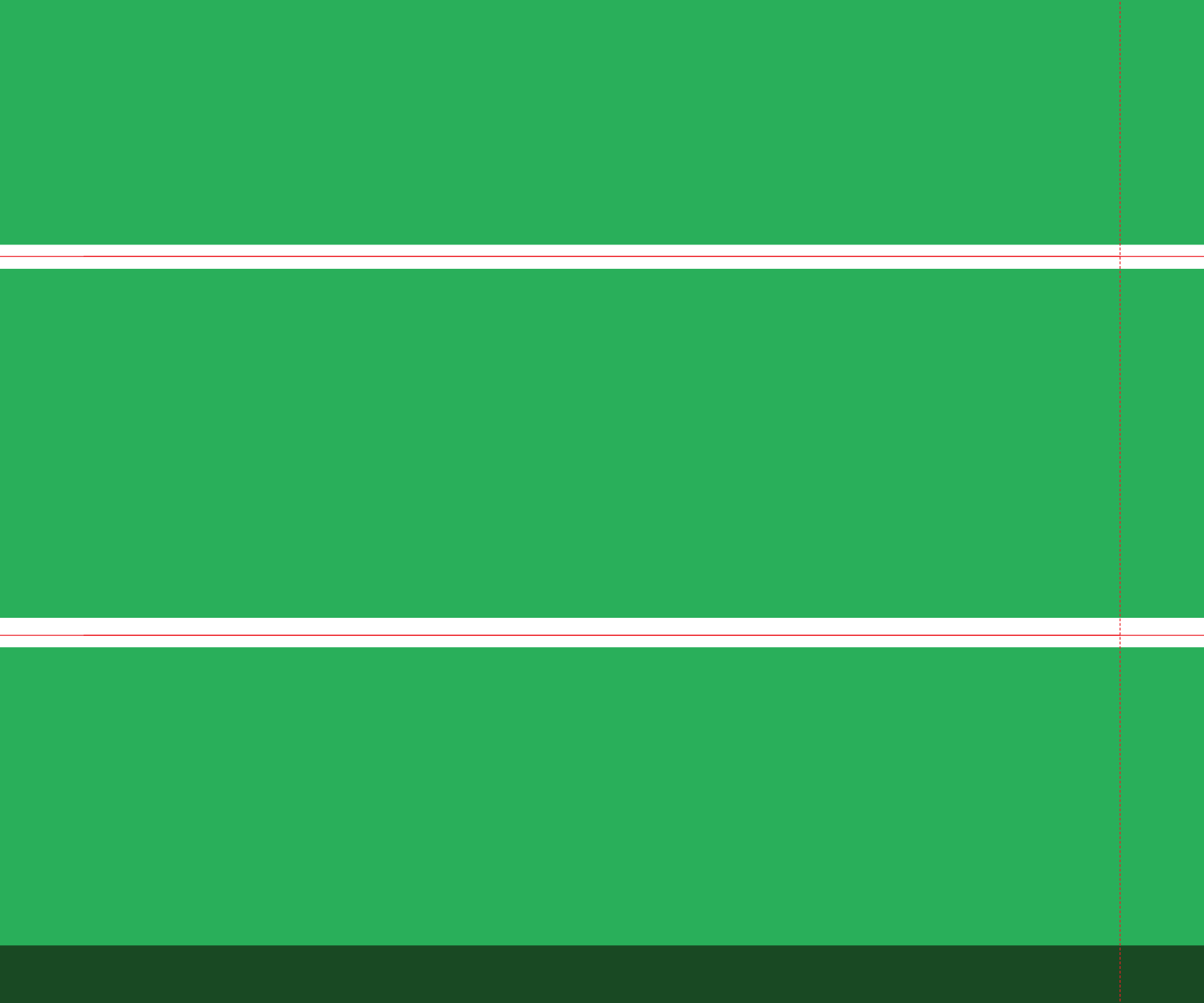

Did you know?

- Holy Name is one of few Catholic high schools in Northeast Ohio to offer a College Credit Plus (CCP) program on campus during the academic day.
- Students have the opportunity to earn **OVER 50 semester hours** of college credit at HN **through CCP and our Advanced Placement Program.**
- Class size on average is 23 students, a **15:1 Student:Teacher Ratio.** We run a **traditional 8-period day.**
- HN offers a variety of textbooks in both print and online format.
- **99% of Holy Name graduates pursue a college degree.**
- Over the past two years, graduating seniors have earned **\$20.1 million in total academic scholarships.**

Holy Name Full Tuition Scholarship

Those who score an overall composite in the 99th percentile on the HN Placement Exam will receive a full tuition scholarship. This scholarship is renewable based upon strong academic achievement.

Holy Name Placement Exam Scholarship

Those who score in the top 25 on the Holy Name placement exam will receive a scholarship ranging from \$1,000 to \$4,500. This scholarship is renewable based upon strong academic achievement.

Holy Name Academic Scholar Award

Available for all incoming Freshmen who earned an A- or higher in all seventh and eighth classes. This is a \$1,000 scholarship that is renewable based upon strong academic achievement.

Holy Name Merit Scholarship

Available for all incoming Freshmen who earned A's and B's in all seventh and eighth grade classes. This is a \$500 scholarship that is renewable based upon strong academic achievement.

Holy Name Music Scholarship

Eighth grade students must audition for a music scholarship. To sign up for an audition, please visit the Admissions page on www.holynamehs.com.

Holy Name Alumni Scholarship

Available for incoming Freshmen whose mother or father has graduated from Holy Name. This \$250 scholarship is renewable.

FINANCIAL AID

Financial aid applications are available on our website, through admissions, and in the Main Office. Please pay close attention to the due dates! Late applications will not be considered for assistance. Financial aid awards are need-based. Additional scholarships and financial aid information is provided each year to families during Freshmen Orientation in the spring. Renewal varies by scholarship. Holy Name reserves the right to amend or terminate scholarships at any time. Financial aid applications must be submitted annually.

ADMISSIONS & TUITION

Eighth grade students must take our placement exam prior to applying to Holy Name. Refer to our Admissions Calendar for dates and registration information. All eighth grade students attending Catholic elementary schools will receive applications from their schools in mid-January. Students attending public or other private schools should request an application from Holy Name prior to the beginning of February. Transfer students should also obtain an application from Holy Name. You may visit our website at www.holynamehs.com to print an online application. Transfers can be made at the beginning of the school year or at semester break, but transfers will not be permitted for a student in his/her senior year. Tuition for the 2016-2017 school year is \$9,550. An additional registration fee will be required every year. Tuition accounts paid in full prior to the start of the year will receive a discount; all other accounts are payable during a 10-month period from July through April with payments due on the 15th of each month.

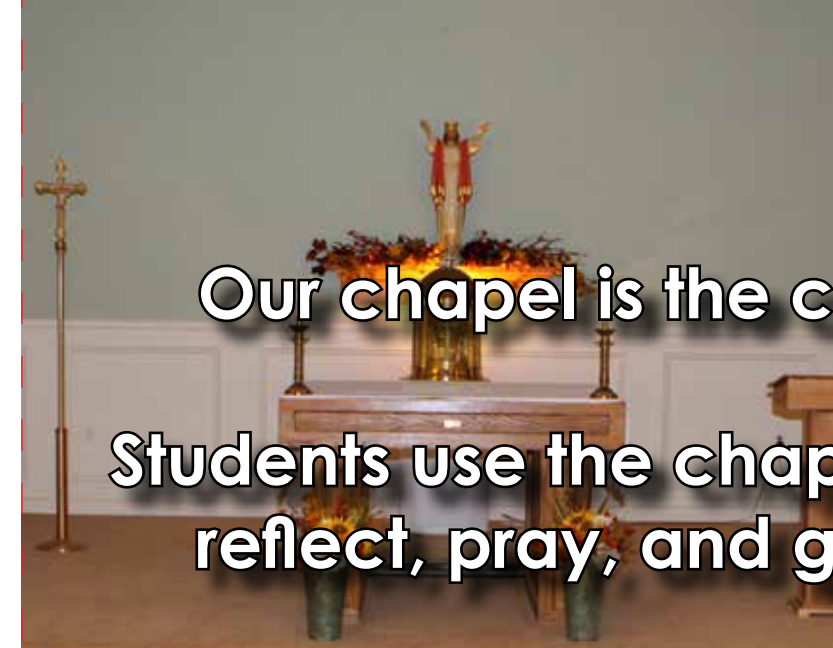

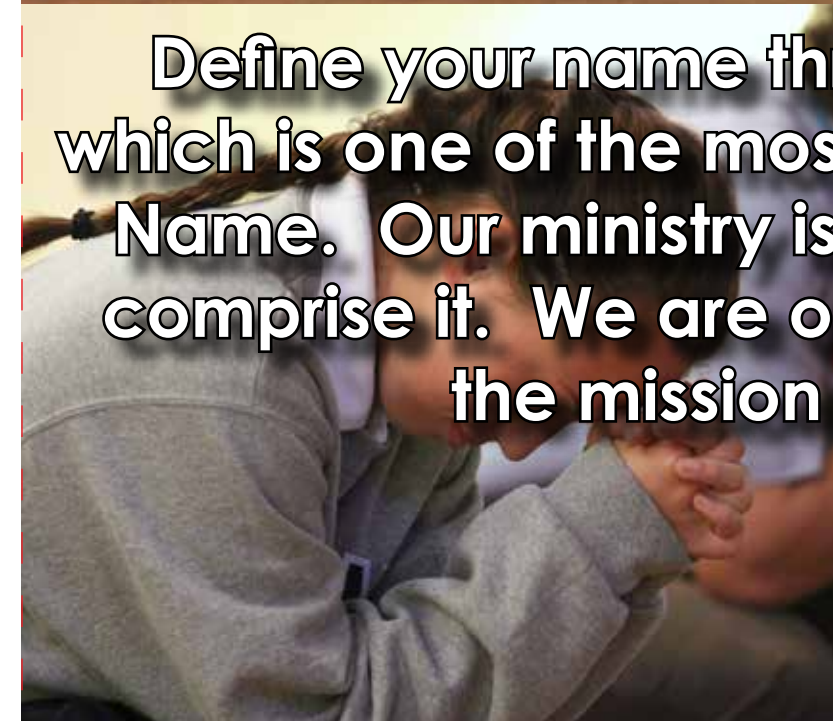
Students at Holy Name admire each other's talents and individualism. You can see it when they help someone find a classroom, cheer for the team, or even carpool to school.

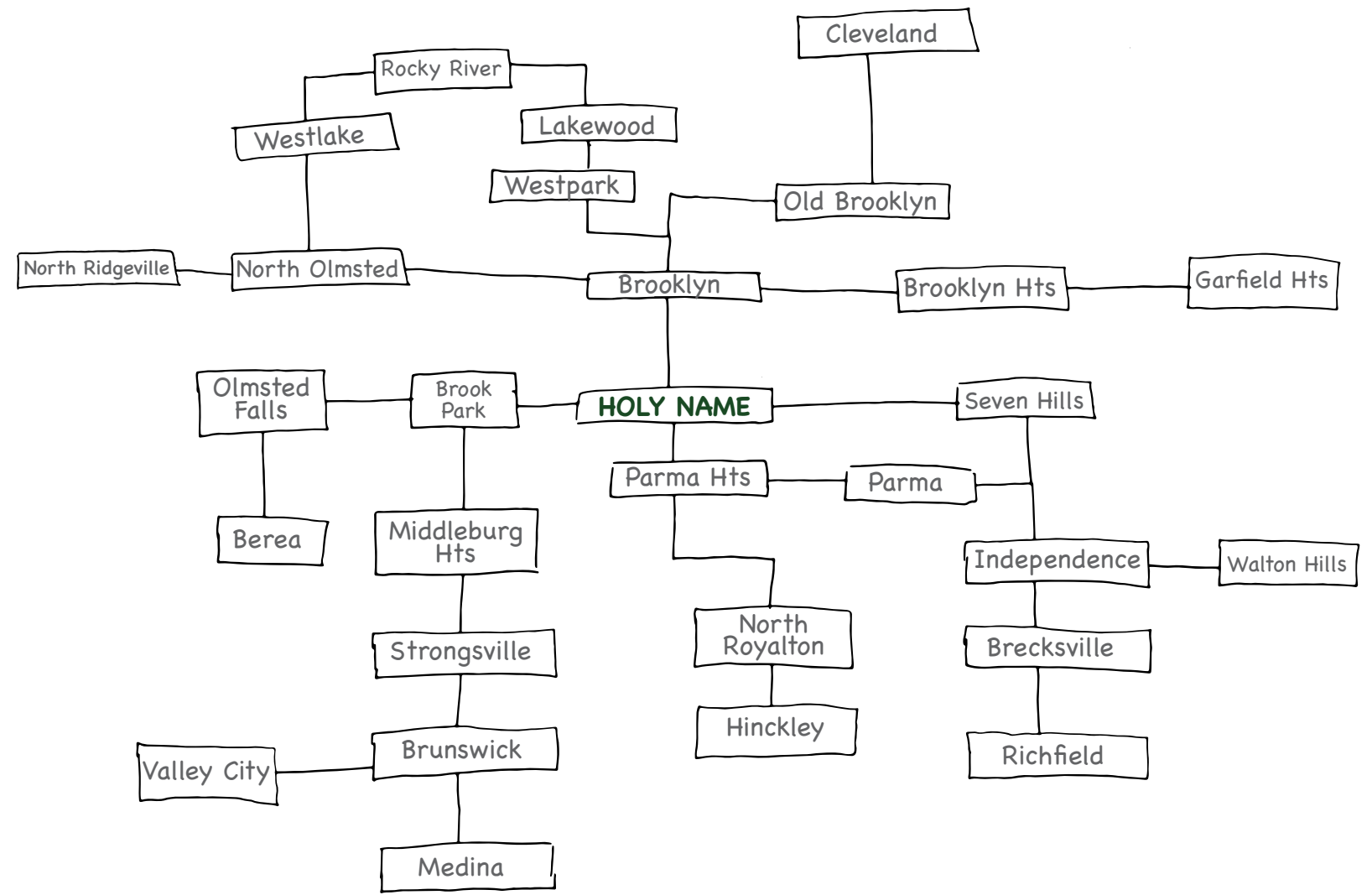
